

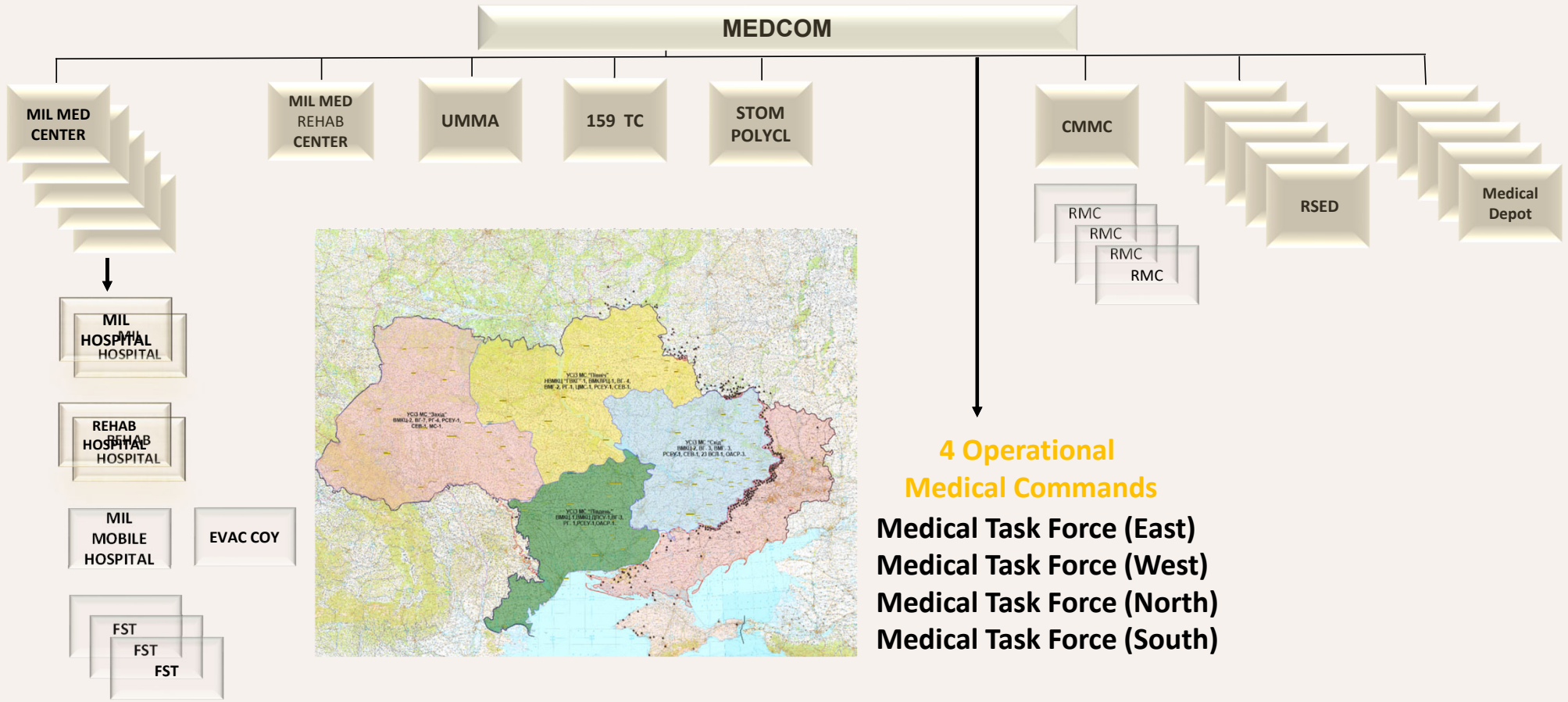

Vision, Mission, and Values of the Medical Forces of the Armed Forces of Ukraine

Vision

The Medical Forces are capable of and prepared for providing medical support to the Armed Forces of Ukraine and other components of the defense forces, delivering medical care to the wounded, injured, traumatized, and ill.

The medical support system enables:

the replenishment of troops (forces) with healthy personnel

the preservation and strengthening of service members' health

the provision of timely, high-quality, and effective medical care

the maintenance of troops' (forces') combat readiness at an appropriate level

Mission – The mission is to ensure effective, timely, and high-quality medical support for the Armed Forces of Ukraine in order to:

- preserve and strengthen the health of service members
- provide them with the necessary medical care following injuries, trauma, and illness
- ensure the rapid restoration of their combat readiness

Values - high professional competence of medical personnel
the health and combat readiness of service members
sanitary and epidemiological well-being of troops (forces)
medical ethics and deontology

Strategic Objectives

- development of the required capabilities
- enhancement of the medical support management system
- advancement in line with NATO standards
- improvement of the organizational and staffing structure
- ensuring high mobility, maneuverability, and autonomy of medical units within military units (formations) and healthcare institutions
- provision of the necessary medical supplies and equipment
- maintaining a high level of readiness of medical units and healthcare institutions
- integration into a unified medical information space and ensuring interoperability, integration, and connectivity with the National Electronic Healthcare System and the medical information space of NATO member states

Doctrinal Provisions on Medical Support

Improvement of doctrinal documents to establish and standardize a unified set of principles

- implementation of NATO standards, principles, and policies for medical support of the armed forces
- strengthening service members' health and preventing disease
- planning, organization, and procedures for the delivery of medical care
- establishment of a unified structure for medical service forces and assets
- organization of medical supply and replenishment of medical materiel, training of medical personnel
- exchange of medical information
- organization of coordination to ensure the effective use of medical resources

Prospective structure of the Medical Forces



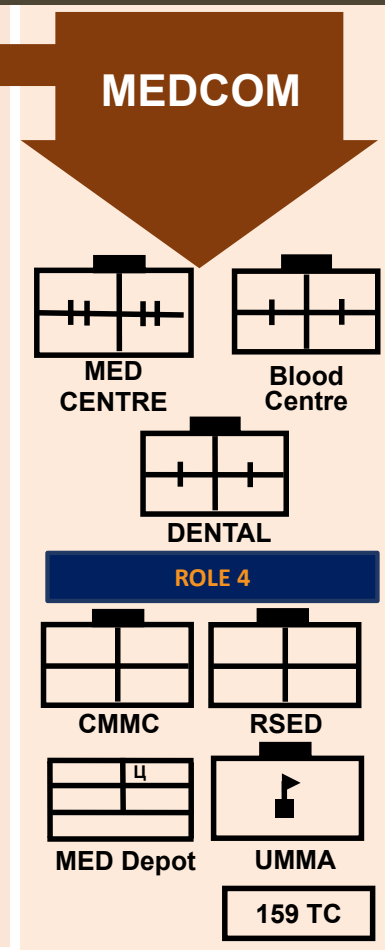
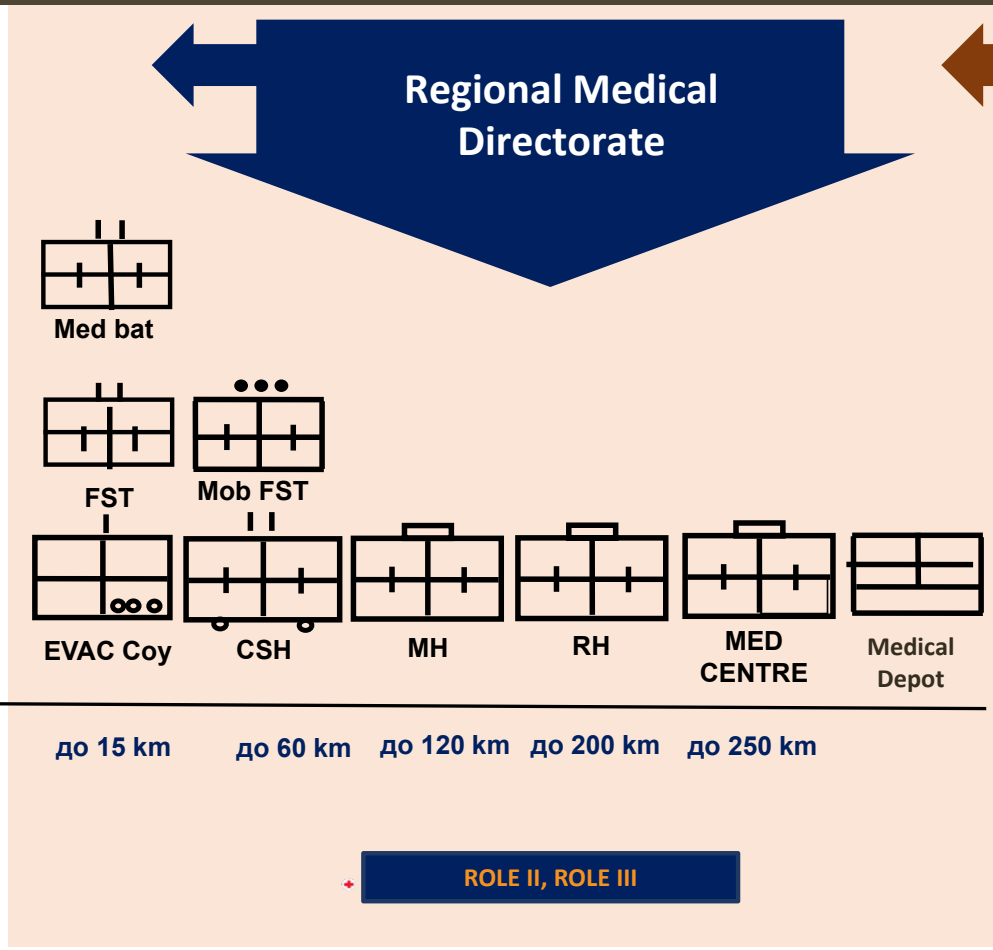
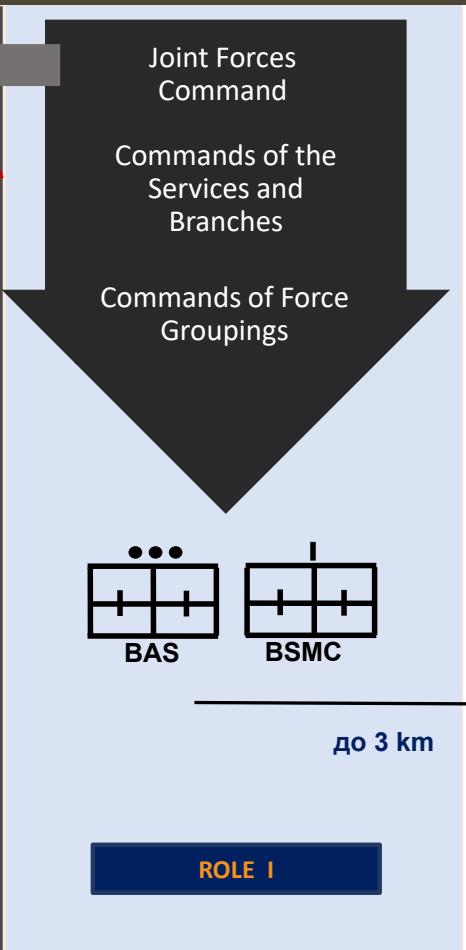
Building capabilities for the effective command and control of medical support forces and assets at the operational level within the framework of the Concept for the Reorganization of the Armed Forces of Ukraine

Exercising direct functional oversight on specialized medical support matters with respect to the medical services of troops (forces) on a territorial basis

Eliminating gaps in the medical support management system identified during the large-scale combat aggression




Prospective Framework for the Organization of Medical Support



Advantages of establishing Regional Medical Directorates

- improve the functioning of the medical support command-and-control chain at the strategic, operational, and tactical levels
- delineate medical support functions between healthcare institutions within the Ministry of Defense of Ukraine system and the medical services of military units
- relieve the operational medical directorates of the Military Medical Clinical Centers (including the National Military Medical Clinical Center) of non-core medical support function
- improve coordination among the medical services of military units within the area of responsibility
- ensure the rational use of resources through the delegation of authority for the management of subordinate healthcare institutions
- organize the establishment of reserves of medical supplies, medical equipment, and human resources
- optimize medical intelligence activities
- improve the organization of medical support for troops (forces) at the operational level within the area of responsibility
- enhance cooperation with public authorities and the leadership of civilian healthcare institutions within the designated area of responsibility
